Day 6: Namche Bazaar - Phortse Thanga

Namche Bazaar - Phortse Thanga (3680m) - 6h.

Day 7: Phortse Thanga - Machhermo

Phortse Thanga - Machhermo (4470m) - 6h.

Day 8: Macchermo - Gokyo

Macchermo - Gokyo (4750m) - 5h.

Day 9: Day in Gokyo

Rest day in Gokyo. Ascent of Gokyo Ri (5483m).

Day 10: Gokyo - Dhole

Gokyo - Dhole (4110m) - 6h.

Day 11: Dhole - Namche Bazaar

Dhole - Namche Bazaar - 6h.

Day 12: Namche Bazaar - Lukla

Namche Bazar-Lukla-6h.

Day 13: Lukla to Kathmandu

Fly from Lukla to Kathmandu-40mins.

Day 14: Farewell

Free day and farewell dinner in the evening.

Day 15: Final Departure
